Back in Romania ---- Summer 2010!! --- Is in the making!!!!

Excitement fills the air as we make all our plans for our summer activities!!!

Please be praying for all our ministry outreaches this summer!!! We are looking forward to a grand year in the Lord and are praying that God will begin to open up the hearts of all the children, youth, and adults as we prepare to minister HIS word. We have already received word from the young volunteers that helped us last year that they are looking forward to our summer activities. Please pray as we minister His name not only in the surrounding villages of Ferma Larga/Cojocna but also as we minister through humanitarian aid.

Ferma Larga Construction Project:

Each year since 2006, we have worked little by little to make improvements on the building in Ferma Larga. Many of you have helped tremendously by actual physical labor and others through your financial means and prayer. I believe we have accomplished much on this project considering that the building when purchased was in such critical condition. We have repaired the roof, put on gutters, and broken walls (very hard labor) in all the upstairs rooms. We put new beams to reinforce the wall structure, poured cement on all the upstairs rooms (to level the flooring), plastered and painted the upstairs inside walls, installed vinyl on the floor in the school room, and installed wood heaters and everything else to make the schoolroom functional. We installed windows, doors (in some of the upstairs rooms), a new front entry door, an electric meter and fuse box, electrical outlets/light fixtures in some of the upstairs rooms, and let us not forget the most valuable of all, the outdoor bathroom facility.

Through both American and Romanian teams, much time and work efforts have been invested into this project each year as you have faithfully stood with us each step of the way. We have tried to use the money sparingly to get the most work accomplished each year.

Please, I am asking you to be in prayer with us regarding the construction project for this summer. For the last 2 years my hopes have been to hire Romanian workers to help plaster the outside of this building. We are losing so much of our red brick that it concerns me to go another year without this work being done. **The red brick is the structure of the building!** Over the years you have helped us in this work and much has been accomplished in securing this building. Together we have worked to renovate a facility for:

- Adults, Youth, and Children Weekly Outreaches. We put much time in ministering to the spiritual conditions of all the surrounding villagers.
- Education-Many of the children are now receiving an education in a safe and clean classroom which they had never experienced before because you faithfully helped to make the project a success.

By all means, I understand that this is a great work task to undertake. Yet, it is needful to provide the safety that is needed as so many children, youth, and adults enter this building. The project is well overdue because I haven't had sufficient funding to cover all the cost for this one project. While I was home I began a fund, and as of now, I only have \$1,950.00 donated. It will take much more funding considering this is a very large building to plaster.
